Wonderful Wildlife

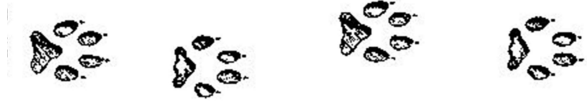
Thursday, February 20, 9:00 AM - 3:00 PM
